Nomination papers for the parish election may be obtained from The Clerk to the Parish Council or West Berkshire Council, Council Offices, Market Street, Newbury, RG14 5LD from the Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered by hand to the Returning Officer, West Berkshire Council, Council Offices, Market Street, Newbury RG14 5LD on any working day after the date of this notice but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 7th June 2024.
3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th July 2024.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 18th June 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Berkshire Council, Council Offices, Market Street, Newbury, RG14 5LD by 5 pm on Wednesday, 19th June 2024. <https://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote>
6. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Berkshire Council, Council Offices, Market Street, Newbury RG14 5LD by 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. <https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote>
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Berkshire Council, Council Offices, Market Street, Newbury, RG14 5LD by 5 pm on Thursday, 4th July 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024.
8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 26th June 2024.
